Fall Book Study

You are invited to participate in an evening book study as we celebrate our life together as a community of faith at the Church of the Ascension.

"LIFE TOGETHER" by Dietrich Bonhoeffer

While Dietrich Bonhoeffer's life was cut tragically short at the age of 39 when he was executed by the Nazis in April 1945, he remains one of the most influential theologians and pastors of the twentieth century. His meditation on Christian community – entitled *Life Together* – remains a relevant description of what it means to be a Christian and how Christians are called by God to live in a community that is shaped by the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

As part of our preparation for the parish's 6oth anniversary, a group of parishioners will be reading and discussing Bonhoeffer's *Life Together* in September and October, led by Fr. Bob Derrenbacker. Fr. Bob will be introducing the book to the church at both services during the sermon time on September 14. What will follow will be four Sunday evening study sessions at the Rev. Anne's home at 7:00 p.m. – September 28, October 5, 19, and 26.
