

Beyond the "Evolution" vs. "Creation" Debate Laurentian University, October 24, 2014, 7:30 PM

Are there only two positions on origins: evolution or creation? This presentation is an introduction to terminology, science-religion dialogue, and various views on origins young earth creation, progressive creation (old earth creation), evolutionary creation (theistic evolution), deistic evolution, and atheistic evolution.
