Reflection on the Baptism of Jesus

"On you my favour rests."

John poured the water, God sent the Spirit. It is the usual cooperation we know as a sacrament. We perform the sign. God provides the grace.

Our cooperation in the event of grace in our world is a significant part of the story. Sometimes we sit on our hands, waiting for God to go to work. We forget that God is waiting for an invitation from us that only we can provide.

What may God be hoping to do through you this week? Look for opportunities to offer God's peace to someone.
