Fundraiser for Zawadi La Tumaini

Thank you for the donation of \$500 from the Christmas outreach money for Zawadi La Tumaini 9 parishioners attended a fundraiser for Zawadi la Tumaini on Saturday, Feb 20th. Zawadi la Tumaini is a children's home near Nairobi, Kenya founded in 2013 by a young Sudburian woman - Jacqueline Villeneuve. The home currently cares for 22 previously abandoned or orphaned children providing them with proper nutrition, education, health care and a warm family environment. Jackie and staff are truly amazing and inspirational as they tackle life's challenges. Jackie stated emphatically that the home has not, nor will not, give bribes. The Ascension has, and continues to support Zawadi la Tumaini. There are now volunteer and sponsoring opportunities. Please check these out on the bulletin board by the church doors.

Cursillo Weekend

We are pleased to announce, the Diocese of Algoma's first co-ed Cursillo Weekend – open to both men and women. The Deanery of Temiskaming is hosting this, but the location is Villa Loyola in Sudbury. What is Cursillo? Cursillo is a Spanish word pronounced "Kur-see-yo" which means short course. The full title is Cursillo de Christiandad, meaning a short course in Christian living. The purpose of Cursillo is to present a method of living which is fundamental for being a Christian in the world, that is, Cursillo presents a way of structuring our Christian lives so as to make a difference in the world. The Cursillo weekend is open to any Baptized adult Christian who is ready for learning and growing experience attained through worship, study, fellowship and personal reflection. (There is also lots of laughter, fun, music and food at a Cursillo weekend)

The Cursillo weekend starts on Thursday evening, and ends late Sunday afternoon. It is a live-in weekend, and candidates are expected to remain for the entire weekend.

A Ministry of Care

Every week we pray for those who aren't able to join us for worship. For the last several years Thelma Smith has been sending these people the weekly bulletin and announcements. Thelma is no longer able to take care of this task and we are in need of someone to take it on. It consists of mailing 8-10 letters a week.

Syrian Emergency Relief

The government of Canada has extended the deadline for matching funds for eligible donations to Canadian agencies working to provide relief to Syrians displaced within Syria and living as refugees in the surrounding countries to February 29, 2016.

Funds raised will provide assistance to meet the ongoing humanitarian needs of those affected by the conflict in Syria, including shelter, food security, health care, water and livelihoods. 2.4 million people are in need of shelter in Syria according to the UN 2016 Humanitarian Needs Overview.

PWRDF continues to respond to the needs of displaced Syrians through the ACT Alliance and the Canadian Foodgrains Bank, as well as through its long-time partner Refuge Egypt in Cairo. The ACT Alliance appeal for 2016 is a continuation of its 2015 appeal and PWRDF has approved CAD \$300,000 from designated donations for the 2016 appeal.

Thanks to the generosity of Anglicans in Canada, PWRDF has received over \$526,000 for the ongoing Syrian refugee crisis.
